Dear Network Members,

Shropshire Scouts are organising an Explorer Belt discovery event for network members who are interested in finding out more about the award, speaking to award holders and getting the opportunity to join a team and start the process.

The event is set to take place over 2 days where the participants will be involved in workshops, presentations, team building and planning sessions with the aim to complete the event with teams set and a plan of action to go forward. This event is open to any UK Scout Network member who will be aged 24 and under on 1st August 2027. Day 1 is planned to be an introduction to the award, presentation from previous award holder and a social with no obligation to register. Day 2 will be the formal award registration and commitment, the start of the initial planning of location, teams, and fundraising ideas.

The event will incorporate an overnight residential in the venue to promote team bonding and planning. Individuals who would like to stay overnight are requested to bring suitable sleeping accommodations (Sleeping Bag, Roll Mat, etc); indoor accommodation will be within a mixed sex room(s) in a sleepover style residential with single sex ablutions/changing areas. Individuals are welcome to bring a small personal tent to sleep outdoors on the venue grounds if they would prefer more privacy.
